

# From the Principal

Worrall Families.

We are proud to say that we have had a great start to the school year at Worrall Elementary. The students of Worrall came out to show their school pride at the MN Youth Night and took home the trophy for the 3rd year in a row. The tremendous turnout reflects the closeness and pride of our wonderful school community. Worrall is a happy but hard-working place.

Every year Worrall has an overarching building theme. The theme for this year is, "Be the Star That You Are". This theme plays an important role with our Bully Prevention/Character Education programs where our children are asked to make good choices and exhibit positive behaviors. In conjunction with this theme, we also have a reading incentive for the students: "Read for the Stars". We kicked off the reading incentive with a traditional Worrall event – the Big Buddy Book Bash. School Board Members will be invited to participate as guest readers at the February BBBB. (Look for the "save the date" coming soon!) The overarching theme also ties in with the Service Projects that Dr. Renee Cahill and Worrall Student Leaders implement during the year to promote awareness of needs in our community. We are wrapping up Mad Hatter Mondays where hats and donations were collected for cancer patients. The Worrall community is kind and generous and will be participating in many future service projects including Can Collections, Toy Collections, PJ/Book Collections, Cradle for Crayons, Un-Birthday Day for children in the hospital, etc.

Frank Long and Team Inspiration have done a great job with their Motivational Mondays. This year the message is "Dig in! Trudge! and One more time!" The students have learned to take on adversity, work hard, and never say, "I can't."

The faculty has done a wonderful job getting to know and work with the new Reading Wonders Series. They have worked hard over the summer and each week to prepare their lessons in order to fully implement this new series.

# **Continued: From the Principal**

In preparation for PSSA testing, we have fully implemented the Classroom Diagnostic Tools for the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students. Every student from 3rd to 5th grade has completed the math and reading CDT test. They will also do a writing test and the 4th grade will do a science test. These tests will be given three times prior to the PSSA tests. The teachers have been shown the data tools and how to access this data for their students empowering them to even better meet the academic needs of the students.

Worrall Elementary will be working with Linwood Elementary of Chichester School District as part of the Governor's Award Grant. A team of teachers are currently working on a reciprocation tool that will be shared with Linwood Elementary. The \$25,000 grant requires Worrall to create a reciprocation tool to teach a school in another district (assigned Chichester) who scored in the mid 60% in math on how to increase their scores for the PSSA tests. The team will present their work at the SAS Conference in Hershey in December.

We are looking forward to a great year!
